Campbell Foundation

Chemist Richard Campbell Zahn invented Herpecin-L, a lip balm for treating cold sores. After his death in 1995 from complications from AIDS, his estate sold assets, including Herpecin-L,

and used the proceeds to endow the Campbell Foundation, a foundation Zahn had started in 1986 to support alternative, non-traditional research on preventing and treating HIV/AIDS. It has given away \$9 million and, at last report, had \$8.2 million in assets. Funders Concerned about AIDS now ranks the foundation among the top HIV/AIDS funders in the nation. **FI**
